For the week, the DOW was up 0.8%; the S&P was up 0.4%, the NASDAQ was down 0.3%; and the Russell 2000 was up 2.5%. The important news was on Friday, when markets were closed. The "PCE," or Personal Consumption Expenditures, the Fed's favored inflation measure, was announced for February rising at a 2.8% annual rate. The expected number, but still higher than the Fed's target, and signaling that 3 rate cuts in 2024 may be high. If we want to nerd out, somebody can 'splain to us the difference between PCE and the more familiar CPI - Consumer Price Index.
