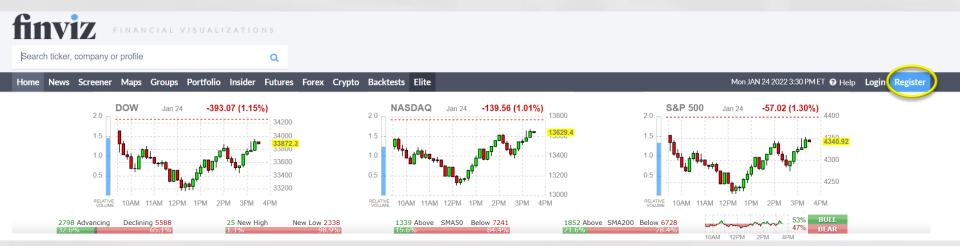

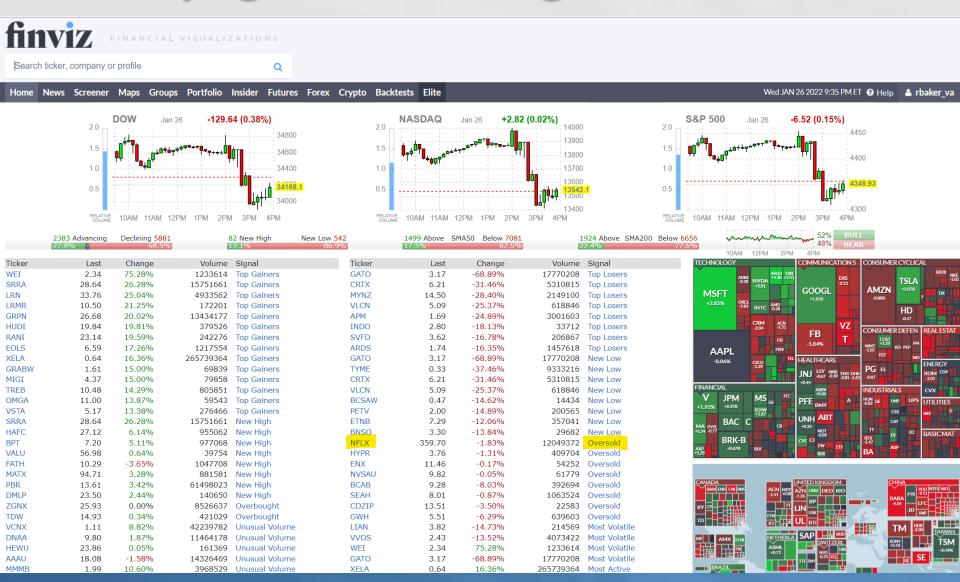

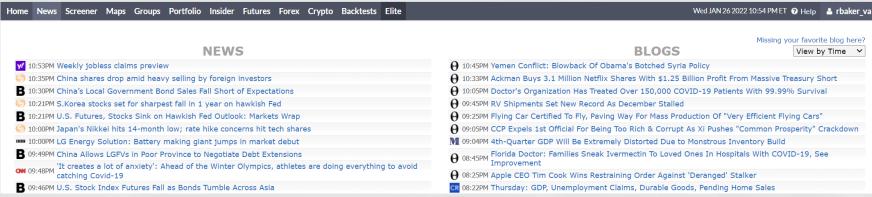

Heat Map – S&P 500

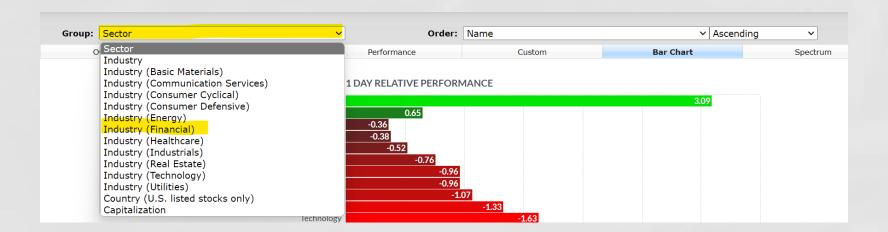


Heat Map – ETFs

Menu Function: Screener

□ Screener and viewing functions serve as the tool's engine.
 □ Traders and investors can filter for stocks based on specific criteria, and FinViz returns every stock that fits that criteria.
 □ Extremely fast; filters easily changed to narrow the outcome.
 □ Filters include the following categories:
 □ Descriptive filters – e.g. market cap, industry, volume, etc.
 □ Fundamental filters – e.g. P/E, Price/Cash, EPS, Quick Ratio, etc.
 □ Technical filters – e.g. 20-, 50-, 200-day simple moving averages, chart patterns, volume anomalies, MACD, etc.

Use predefined "Signals" – events that indicate actionable conditions.

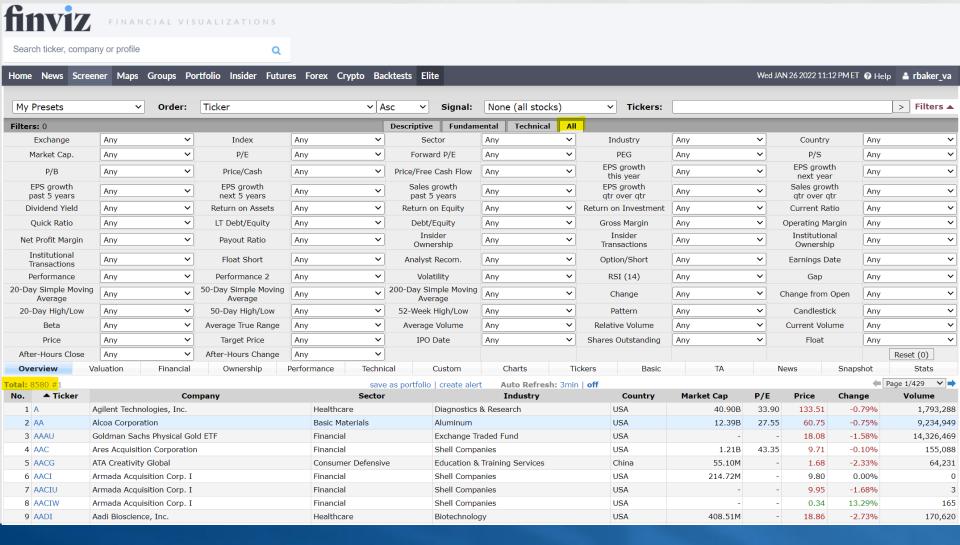

- ☐ Sort and filter stocks by quickly examining their data and metrics against a set of criteria (predefined or custom).
- ☐ Growth focused investors may look to several key factors when evaluating stocks: historical and future earnings growth; profit margins; returns on equity (ROE); and share price performance*.
- ☐ For Dividend focused investors, goal is to find stocks that pay a regular, safe, sustainable and growing dividend, at good value, good earnings history and outlook.
- ☐ Screen in stages from course to fine, narrowing results.

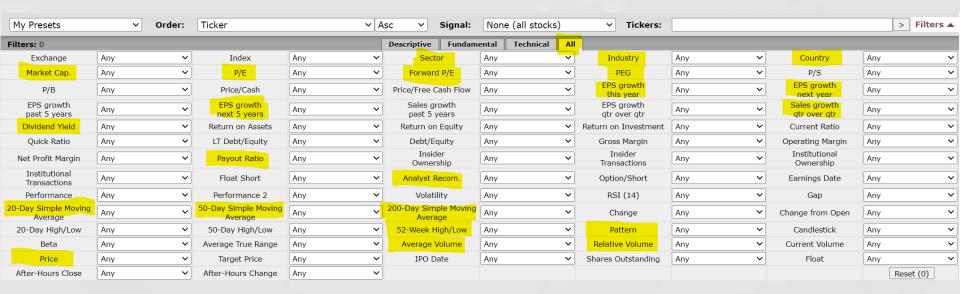

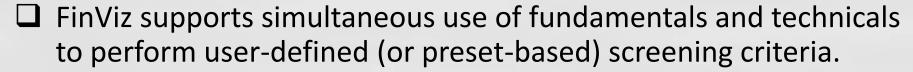

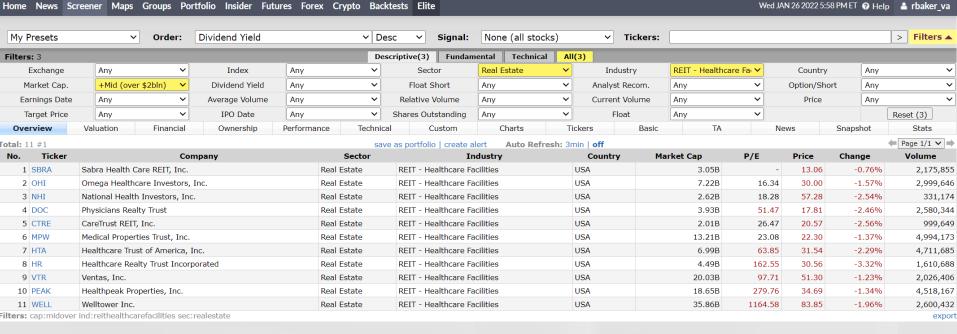

Scre	eening criteria should be kept minimal per your choosing, and
may	y include such metrics as:
	Market Cap, Sector, Industry, Country, Volume
	Dividend Yield, Safety, Growth History
	Payout Ratio (or AFFO for REITs)
	Debt-to-Equity Ratio
	P/E Ratio (TTM/FWD) (know what's "good" and "market average")
	EPS Growth (TTM and FWD); Sales/Revenue Growth; Profit Margins
	PEG Ratio (price/earnings to growth ratio)
Stai	rt with predefined screens; customize, refine and save (Presets)

Technicals

- ☐ Methodology for evaluating stocks by examining chart patterns and factors related to price and volume movement.
- Technical analysis of chart patterns support decisions of when to buy and when to take profits based on chart "signals" or actionable events, including:
 - Price trends
 - Chart patterns
 - Volume and momentum indicators
 - Moving averages
 - Support and resistance levels



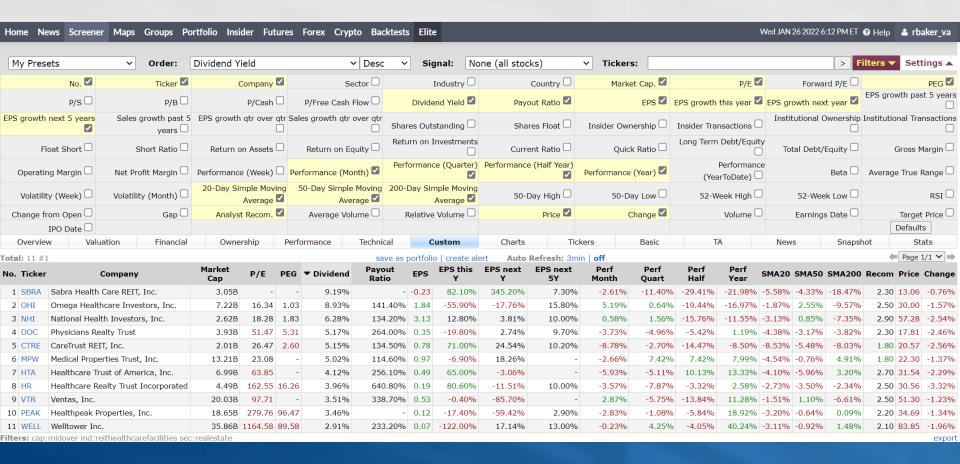

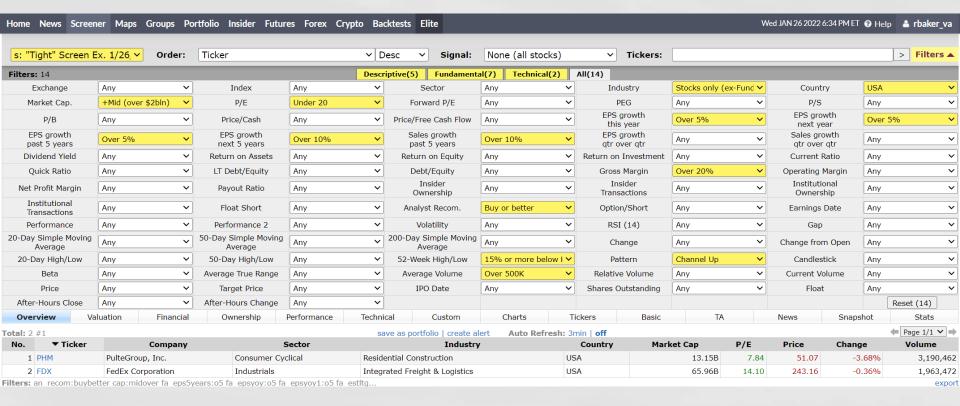

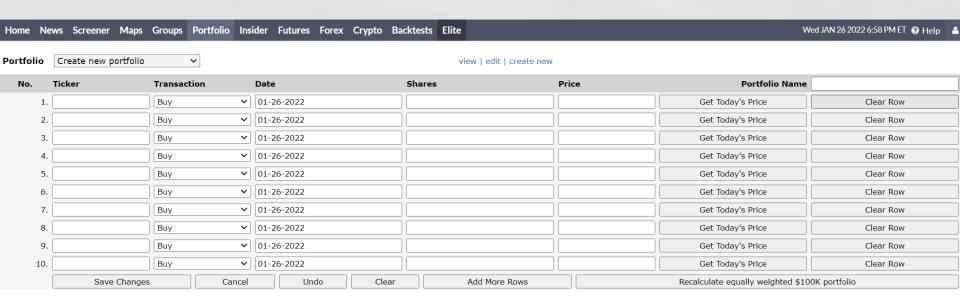

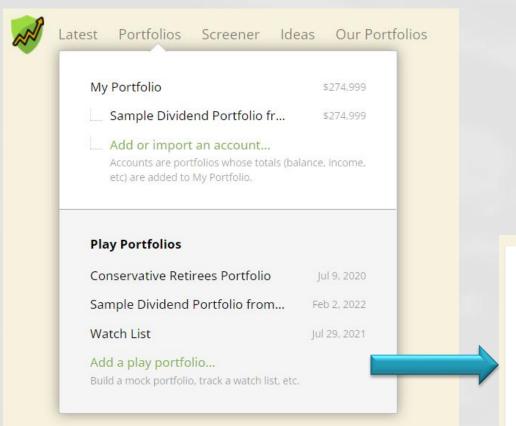

Monthly Recap

Despite entering 2021 with a forward P/E ratio near 22, its highest level in two decades, the S&P 500 finished the year with a 28% gain.

This marked the third consecutive year of double-digit returns as the market blew past virtually every analyst's year-end price target issued 12 months earlier.

Corporate earnings momentum fueled the rally. Profits generated by S&P 500 companies have tracked about 25% higher in 2021 compared to analysts' estimates at the start of last year.

From more persistent inflation to supply chain disruptions and new Covid variants, nothing has managed to disrupt the economic recovery. That trend is projected to continue in 2022 with analysts expecting S&P 500 profits to climb another 9%.

But unlike in 2021, unprecedented monetary support measures put in place by the Fed to boost the pandemic-stricken economy are likely to begin unwinding as efforts increase to combat inflation.

These stimulus actions centered on slashing short-term interest rates to 0% and buying over \$100 billion of Treasuries and mortgagebacked securities each month to put downward pressure on longterm borrowing costs.

The Fed's bond holdings more than doubled during the pandemic to

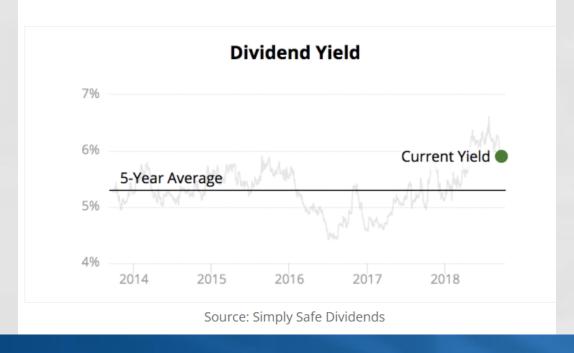

Supplemental Stuff

Dividend Yield Theory

Dividend yield theory is simple and intuitive. It basically says that for blue-chip dividend stocks, meaning those with stable business models that don't significantly change over time, dividend yields tend to revert to the mean.

In other words, a stock's dividend yield fluctuates around a relatively fixed level over the years that approximates fair value. If the stock's current yield is far enough above its historical yield, then the stock is likely undervalued. And if its yield is beneath its historical norm, then the stock could be overvalued.
