

## PURPOSE OF THE CLASS

- The goal of this class is to help OLLI members understand the use of online tools to help them make better investment decisions
- Morningstar has some <u>free</u> tools and data that make it easier for investors to compare investments

# SPECIFIC FOCUS – THE PORTFOLIO TOOL

- We will focus on it because:
  - It helps you review your existing portfolio
  - It helps you assess the value of <u>new</u> positions
- Also, because
  - Morningstar is a familiar platform for many of us
  - It's free

#### **FLEXIBILITY**

- Each portfolio can hold up to 100 ticker symbols\* of Stocks, ETFs, Mutual Funds
- You can bring many data fields together for each ticker on one "view"
- You can customize the data you see on the page from over 120 pieces of information (although some require a paid subscription)
- They have standard views (not customizable)
- They have 4 views that you can customize with respect to
  - Data selected (up to 35 fields), column order, name of view
- You can sort by any column (that's a data field like YTD Total Return)

<sup>\*</sup> I may in the course of this presentation, refer to the contents of the portfolios as tickers, ticker symbols, equities, or positions. It's all the same.

#### **BREADTH OF COVERAGE**

- You can have many portfolios
  - I have 48
  - I really need to delete ones I am not using
- Portfolios can represent:
  - Current Holdings
  - What-if scenarios
  - Evaluation of an idea (sector, industry, factor)
  - Benchmark/reference portfolios
  - Comparison of current holdings to "benchmarks"

#### **WORK WITH OTHER TOOLS**

- Look at it online
- Export the data to excel
  - I do this all the time
  - For better filtering and comparisons
  - Merging with data from other sources
  - Narrowing focus for thinking and printing
- Import a portfolio from Excel (actual from a .csv file)
- Get news (i.e., emails) about the tickers in the portfolio
- Save it, so you have it whenever you log in

Neat Huh?

#### **FLEXIBILITY OF OUTPUTS**

- There are two flavors\*, with different goals:
  - Portfolios
    - Positions you have with buys, sells, prices, quantities
    - Let's you report on your personal returns in addition to the general metrics
  - Watchlists
    - Equities you are thinking about
    - You can only get the general metrics
    - This, however, is usually good enough

<sup>\*</sup>Even though there are two flavors we will call the tool the *Portfolio Tool*. When I use the term *portfolio* it will be the umbrella covering both flavors

#### MOST OF THESE THINGS YOU CAN GET FROM YOUR BROKER

- It's not a screener
  - You have to find the investments and populate the portfolios
- It can hold Bond Funds but not individual bonds
- The views don't change if you are looking at stocks rather than funds
- It's not an X-Ray tool. It doesn't give you insights to the inside of funds
  - e.g., % Mid-cap, %Tech or overlaps between funds
- It does not integrate with your brokerage account
  - If you want to keep your portfolio up to date, you have to do it manually
  - That could mean adding all your buys and sells and re-investments if you want to see your personal performance
  - I don't use this feature. I use my brokerage account for status and performance

Not so neat, hmm?

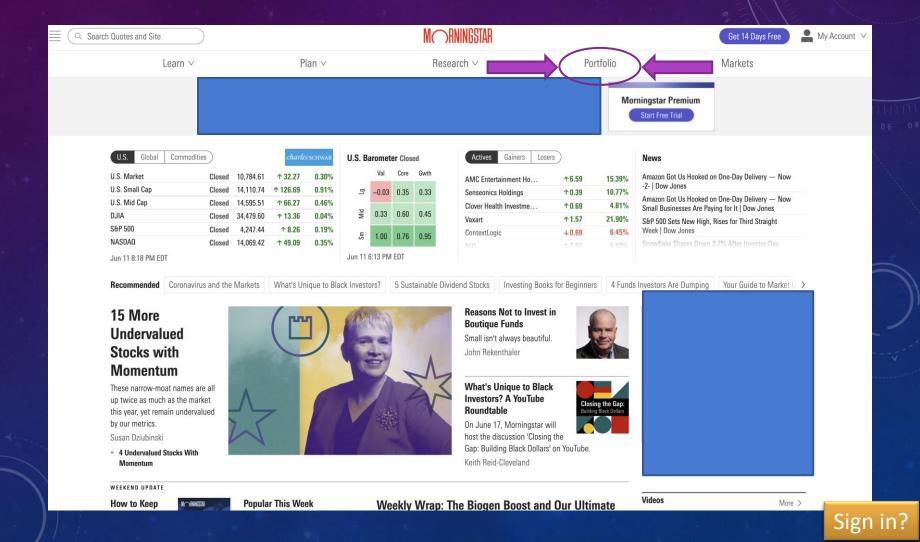

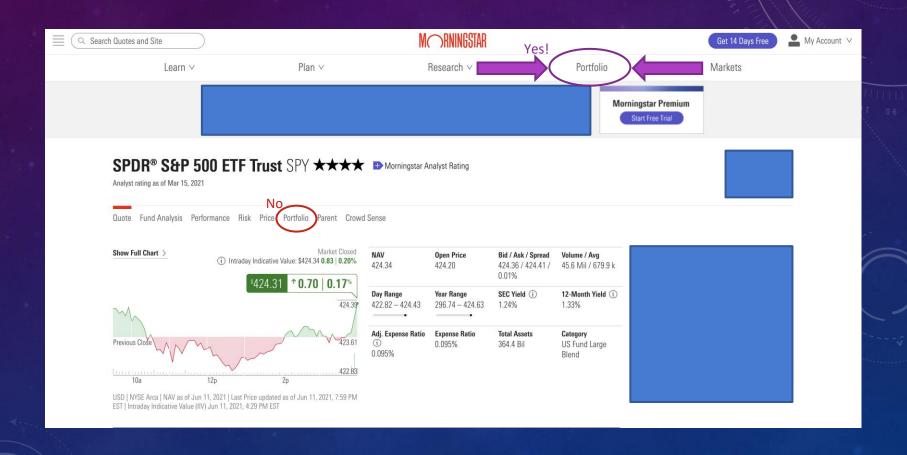

#### THERE ARE SEVERAL MORNINGSTAR SITES AND FLAVORS

Tool	Morningstar free, no sign-in	Morningstar free Basic Membership	Morningstar paid Premium Membership	Morningstar free via Fairfax library account	
Portfolio tool	No	Yes But, Premium data is not accessible	Yes Premium data included	Very limited portfolio tool e.g., Cannot save between sessions	
X-ray tool	No	No	Yes	Yes (on the limited portfolio) Also, multipage Analysis reports

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### WHAT TOOLS DO I USE?

I AM MOSTLY A FUND INVESTOR WITH ONLY A FEW INDIVIDUAL STOCKS

- Morningstar
  - Portfolio tool with free basic account for data consolidation, comparisons and What-if/Thinking-about scenarios
  - Library version for detailed fund write-ups
- My brokerage account tools (Fidelity)
  - Screeners (better quality screener and why get funds from M\* that I can't invest in at my broker)
  - Portfolio Analysis (X-Ray equivalent)
  - Personal Portfolio Performance
  - Analysis reports from various services (Zachs, CFRA, etc.)

### WHAT OTHER TOOLS DO I USE?

I AM MOSTLY A FUND INVESTOR WITH ONLY A FEW INDIVIDUAL STOCKS

- ETFDB.COM, ETF.COM
  - get lists of ETFs
- FinViz (<a href="https://finviz.com/">https://finviz.com/</a>) Just starting, thanks to Bob Baker's recommendation
  - Screener
- Portfolio Visualizer (<a href="https://www.portfoliovisualizer.com/">https://www.portfoliovisualizer.com/</a>)
  - Back-testing ideas
- Other geekier stuff
  - Excel, Google Sheets, my own custom software programs, etc.
