## Independent Analyst - Investopedia Definition

- Sell-Side Analysts
  - Employed by brokerage houses
  - In-depth reports on a few stocks
  - Used to sell ideas to individuals and institutions
- Buy-Side Analysts
  - Employed by fund managers
  - Shorter reports but on 2-3 times more stocks than the sell-slide analysts
  - Used to make fund investment decisions
- Independent Analysts
  - May be employed by research firms but not employed by brokerages nor funds
  - May have subscriptions, fees or trade based compensation from funds
  - They must include a disclosure at the end of each report (its often in the fine print)

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## How do we use Analyst Opinions?

- Source of fundamental metrics?
- Forecasts (yes)
  - Revenue growth, earnings
  - Target price
  - Dividend growth and safety
- Discussions of...?
  - Market/sector/industry outlook/insights
  - Positioning in the sector/industry
  - Potential M&A & other news
  - Risks for the company
  - Company plans
  - Negative analyses esp Seeking Alpha
  - Reader comments on Seeking Alpha posts
  - Reasons, not to buy (esp from Zacks)

- History and trends?
- Recommendations (yes)
  - Buy/Hold/Sell
  - Strong Buy/Buy/Hold/Underperform/Sell
  - Overweight/Neutral/Underweight
  - Scores (eg, 1-5)
- Consensus or Favorites?
  - Follow a guy you know is good
  - Look for consensus across analysts
  - Side-by-side comparison of analyst reports for a given company
- Screens or Due Diligence
  - Al noted that analyst views get about a 5% weighting in his decisions

- Individuals (eg, Seeking Alpha)
- Research Firms
  - Morningstar, Value Line
  - Argus, CFRA, Zacks, Ford Equity, Refinitiv Verus (aka Thompson Reuters/ Verus), ISS-EVA, Jefferson, McLean Capital, Refinitiv I/B/E/S,...
- Summary Scorecards
  - "Tip Ranks" for individual investors (Bob discussed this last week)
  - Starmine
  - Investars
  - Integrity Research Associates

A research firm that adheres to a growth style believes that growth prospects or growth history is the most important factor in valuing a company. They may look at revenue growth, profit growth, or margin growth, but they all try to identify stocks worth owning based on growth that is not being recognized in a company's stock price.

#### **Value**

A research firm that adheres to a value style tries to buy companies whose assets are underpriced. Those assets may be physical assets, like equipment and real estate or streams of revenue and profits from customers. They may also include intangibles such as brand or reputation. Value investing is often associated with Graham and Dodd, and their book *Security Analysis*.

#### **How to Choose**

While investors may be comfortable with a growth or a value approach to investing, it's also important to look at the markets and see whether value or growth stocks are being favored. During periods when growth stocks are leading, you may see the performance of value—oriented research firms lag. Conversely, when value stocks are leading, growth—oriented research firms' performance may lag. Also, in certain industries or sectors, one of the approaches may be more typically used. Or conversely, when value stocks are leading, growth-oriented research firms' performance may lag. Also, in certain industries or sectors, one approach or the other may be more typically used.

## Investars Scorecard \*

- Measures performance in 3 recommendation categories Buy, Hold, Sell
  - But, Fidelity reports only the "buy recommendations" results
- Methodology
  - Measures 2-year performance of all Buy recommendations
  - Keeps a hypothetical portfolio of all buy recommendations
    - Equal Weighted, Rebalanced monthly
    - New positions added and rebalanced on all new Buy recommendations
    - If a position goes Neutral or Sell it is removed from the portfolio

# StarMine Relative Accuracy from Refinitiv

- Tries to define how well a research firm predicts performance in a <u>sector</u>
- Looks at 2 year Buy and Sell Recommendations <u>relative to other firms</u>
- Grades firms by how well they did
- Normalizes grade from 1-100
- Not a lot of info to tell you how this is calculated
- 100 <u>DOES NOT MEAN</u> THAT THEY ARE RIGHT 100% OF THE TIME
