Market Perspective. Volatility is back! Seems like we have daily moves over 100 points in the DOW, up or down. For the week, the DOW was up 0.7%; the S&P up 0.9%; and the NASDAQ up 1.4%. For the first six months of the year, equities were up 13%, its best performance since 1999, despite being down since mid-May.

Bond prices rose for the week (long-term rates fell) and gold prices continued their decline.

Closed End Funds (continued.) CEFs,

especially those that invest in fixed-income, have been hit hart in the part two months. Many trade at substantial discounts to Net Asset Value, and a number of pundits suggest that they are undervalued. <u>Morningstar</u> listed 25 CEFs that it believes are "on sale."

Last week we looked at several CEFs. This week we will examine some more, using <u>www.cefconnect.com</u> to look under the hood. (This week I will have my User ID and Password so we can get into the site!) CEFs are an interesting investment vehicle that are similar to managed mutual funds, trade like ETFs, and most use leverage to create good yields, but also involve risks that need to be understood.
