Market Perspective. Finally, an up week. For the four-day week, the DOW was up 2.6%; the S&P up 2.8%; and the NASDAQ up 3.9%. The S&P is still down 11% from its all time high last May, so it is still in correction territory. But is the worst of the selling in the past two months past us? The economic news last week did not seem to change much. Global economic growth and China remain a concern. Oil prices are still low, as are interest rates. The US employment numbers still look good.

Recall the market forecasts that we read and talked about last December. Everybody was somewhat optimistic about 2016. Ten pundits in the December 12, 2015 edition of <u>Barron's</u> predicted a 2220 S&P by year-end 2016. (The S&P is now 1918.) Those same pundits now predict a 2105 S&P, with only one of the ten (Stephen Auth) who was the most bullish in December (predicting 2500 year end 2016) now predicting 1850. The others remain relatively optimistic. To reach 2105, the S&P needs to rise 9.7% between now and year-end. Let's hope.
