- Investing is a forward-looking activity. But, correctly foreseeing future events and acting upon them in a proper and timely manner are two different challenges.
- There can be many reasons for individual investors to sell stocks, but two important ones are fundamentals and valuations. Recent history has provided examples that Forum members can easily recall.
- Comments on several prominent electric utility stocks. Consideration of fundamentals and valuations apply here.
- Additional perspectives on value investing. The May 13 issue of *Barron's* (on the Investment Forum website) has an interesting article on value investing that offers some perspectives not previously introduced at the forum. Jim Dann will pair with Tom on the topic.

**Business Development Companies ("BDCs").** BDCs, which I don't believe have ever been discussed at the Forum, are "closed-end investment companies that invest in small and mid-sized companies." We will look at what they do, and how they are structured and taxed, and several examples. BDCs have large distributions, but high risk.
