*Market Perspective.* The S&P and the NASDAQ both finished the week at all-time highs, and last week marked the longest bull market in history. Lets reflect on this remarkable run, and what happens now. (I joined OLLI and the Investment Forum in December, 2007, so my first 16 months in the Forum was during the great recession.)

For the week, the DOW gained 0.47% (up 4.33% YTD;) the S&P gained 0.86% (up 7.52% YTD;) and the NASDAQ gained 1.66% (up 15.10% YTD.) And the 2-10 spread fell to .19%, getting us closer to the inverted yield-curve.

*Options follow-up.* We will periodically have further discussions on options and what they can do. Follow-up observations or questions from last week's discussion are welcome.

**BBB rated bonds in corporate bond funds.** Last week's Barron's had an article on the growing percentage of BBB rated bonds (the lowest investment-grade credit rating) in the corporate bond universe, and that this is a growing risk. Is it?

- Many of the buys are well-known blue chips or funds, expected of retirees' portfolios.
- Others, though, have risks, are little known, or may be generated by specific goals. For example, Tandem Diabetes (TNDM) has had wild price gyrations, from a \$257 high to a \$2 low in the past five years.
- Energy investments are back in favor.
