The Gamestop/RobinHood brouhaha seems to have passed. Mr. Market took to the woodshed most of the Gamestop investors, who bought before last week. Never a good idea to pay \$400 for a \$20 stock, as the RobinHood boys now know. Regulators are looking at this and will likely come up with some responses on broker liquidity or new circuit breakers in a few months. Hopefully, they won't impact the kind of trading we do.

The bond market and yield curve are sending some strong signals on the economy. I will comment.
