Markets

Another week, another set of all-time highs. Despite the Thursday scare when Covid worries rattled the market early, and which were forgotten on Friday. For the week, the DOW was up 0.2%; the S&P and NASDAQ were both up 0.4%; but the Russell 2000 was down 1.1%. Lower bond yields (Higher bond prices) continue to fall - a head scratcher with strong economic growth, which normally signals rising interest rates and falling bond prices.

Second quarter earnings start this week; with expectations of profit growth.

<u>Topics This Week</u>

<u>PEG Ratios.</u> The PEG ratio is the Price/Earnings (P/E ratio) divided by the annual earnings per share growth rate. A company with a P/E of 15, and EPS annual growth of 10%, has a PEG ratio of 1.5. It is a widely used valuation metric used by stock analysts, but not so much followed by individual investors. Forum PEG ration devotees are invited to discuss PEG ratios, and particularly what high PEG ratios signify.

<u>Capital Gains Exclusion on Sale of Primary Residence.</u> I have posted a copy of a <u>Wall Street Journal</u> article, "The Tax Break to Know in a Sellers' Market," on the Forum website.
