For the S&P, a down quarter and a down month - typical for Septembers. And a down week. For the week, the DOW was down 1.4%; the S&P was down 2.2%; the NASDAQ was down 3.2%; and the Russell 2000 was down 0.3%. Bond prices were also down, with the yield on the 10 year Treasury rising. But Friday was a good day, so perhaps October will be a better month. Attention last week was focussed on the debt ceiling, which was extended to December.

September 30, 1981. Long-term bonds hit their nadir, all-time low price, and highest interest rates. The 20-year Treasury yielded 15.78%. Long term bonds commenced a 40-year bull market the next day, with rising bond prices and falling interest rates, that has continued to this day.
