Welcome to the Investment Forum. Once again, I invite our new Forum members to introduce yourselves: what you did, how long you have been retired, why you joined us. We want to get to know you, which is more difficult with Zoom.

Markets. A welcome up week, with the DOW up 5.4%; the S&P up 6.5%; the NASDAQ up 7.5%; and the Russell 2000 up 6.0%. Have we hit bottom, or was last week another "dead cat bounce?" Recall, we had a similar big up week the week May 23, followed by three down weeks. Interest rates and oil prices eased last week, but otherwise not much new in markets.

<u>Market forecasts.</u> Recall the Forum predictions of the market for 2022, taken in December 2021. 67% of us predicted the S&P would rise up to 20% by year-end 2022, while only 33% predicted drops, including 4% of us predicting 20% declines. Morningstar Dividend Investor. As most of you know, I read the Morningstar Dividend Investor monthly newsletter, and forward it to a number of you on a distribution list. The MDI model portfolios have trailed he S&P for a number of years, not unexpected given they are mostly value, dividend paying stocks, rather than growth stocks. But the portfolio is outperforming the S&P this year. Let's take a look at the comparative performances, and the stocks in the current MDI portfolio and the "income bellwethers."
