Markets.

Two nice up weeks since we last met. For the two weeks ending August 12, the DOW was up 2.8%; the S&P was up 3.3%; the NASDAQ was up 5.2%; and the Russell 2000 was up 6.9%. YTD, the averages are out of bear market territory. Did we hit the bottom on June 16? Is it safe to go back in the water? Things kind of feel better, or less scary. The inflation numbers are down a bit, thanks to lower gasoline prices. Jobs' numbers continue strong. Consumer sentiment is better. The Fed will continue to raise interest rates, to tame inflation, but that is baked into the market already. But the yield curve is significantly inverted, with the 10-year .39% lower than the 2-year - a reliable predictor of recession. And absent adjustments in the second quarter GDP, we may be in a recession already.
