<u>Markets.</u>

A nice up week, after three down weeks. The DOW was up 2.7%; the S&P was up 3.7%; the NASDAQ was up 4.1%; and the Russell 2000 was up 4.0%. Was this a short "relief rally" which will be followed by a continuation of the down markets that started in early 2022? Markets are still down over 11% YTD, with the NASDAQ in bear market territory.

Everybody is focussed on interest rates, with three more rate increases likely this year, with the Fed Funds rate projected to climb to 4% by year end, from the current 2.25%. Not enough attention is being paid to Quantitative Tightening (QT) - the Fed rolling off its huge inventory of Treasuries and Mortgage securities. This will start in September, and its impact is unpredictable. We will discuss QT, what it is, and what might happen.
