Markets.

That brief rally the week before last was short-lived. Another bad week last week, with the DOW down 4.1%; the S&P down 4.8%; the NASDAQ down 5.5%; and the Russell 2000 down 4.5%. The big driver was the inflation report on Tuesday, with disappointing numbers for many important components, which will drive the Fed to raise rates higher and longer, with a high risk of a recession. Other worries remain, including quantitative tightening (rolling off of the Fed's huge holdings or securities.) And the strong jobs' market remains, with more jobs available than workers seeking employment. Usually a good thing, but labor shortages are driving up wages, which adds inflationary pressures. So bearish market sentiment is out there. Should investors be selling, hunkered down and hiding, or buying?
