Markets.

Another up week, keeping hopes alive for a "Santa Claus rally" that reduces the pain of 2022. For the week, the DOW was up 0.2%; the S&P was up 1.1%; the NaSDAQ was up 2.1%; and the Russell 2000 was up 1.3%. Some better inflation numbers, and Chairman Powell's comments on Thursday, signaling smaller and more spaced out rate hikes, were the good news. The bad news was on Friday, with higher than expected jobs growth numbers. More good news is bad news when it comes to taming inflation.

Topics this week.

<u>The week that was.</u> Lot's happening domestically and globally. Is anybody making significant changes to allocations or strategy in response to what is going on?

<u>Crypto.</u> Let's talk about crypto, especially from you who have some investment in crypto, exchanges, or decentralized finance. Questions I have: is crypto the future of banking and currency, or is it a Ponzi scheme and scam? what needs to happen to reduce the risk of crypto and exchanges? is a regulatory structure needed? should investors consider crypto and if so, how? What will one Bitcoin be worth in five years? Predictions range from zero (Charlie Munger) to \$1 million (Cathie Wood.)

<u>Preferred-stock ETFs.</u> Time permitting, I will look at preferred stock ETFs, which now yield over 6%, and whether the risks outweigh the higher yields compared to bank CDs.
