For the week, the S&P was up 2.9%, the NASDAQ was up 2.5% and the Russell 2000 was up 4.0%. Bond interest rates dropped slightly, and market consensus is that the Fed will lower rate only one time in 2025, as inflation concerns persist. Fourth quarter earnings will continue to come out, and will drive markets.
