Forum Changes

As Al has mentioned in recent meetings, there are some changes happening in the Forum. Markets

Last week, the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) voted to lower the target range for the federal funds rate by 1/4 point (0.25%) to 3 ¾ % with one member voting for a ½ point cut (0.50%) and one member voting for no change to the rate. The committee also voted to conclude the reduction of its aggregate securities holdings on 1 December.

The DJIA finished up 0.1% for the week, closing at 47,562.87 points S&P 500 finished up 48.51 points, or 0.7%. It closed out its third straight winning week and sixth straight winning month, its longest monthly winning streak since 2021.

NASDAQ finished up 0.6% closing at 23,724.96; the gain for October was 4%

The Russell 2000 index fell by 7.16 points, or 0.6%, to close at 2,479.38 for the week ending October 31, 2025. This decline is part of a broader trend, as the index has seen a decrease of 34.09 points, or 1.4%, over the past year.

Bitcoin closed the week at \$109,556.16, about a 4% decline from Monday's opening price

Gold ended the week at \$4002.72 per oz., a decline for the week of 0.54%. 10-year Treasury Bond yield ended the week at 4.11%, no change from the previous day.
