

Connections and procedure for Docucam image Zoom screen-sharing

CONNECTION DIAGRAM

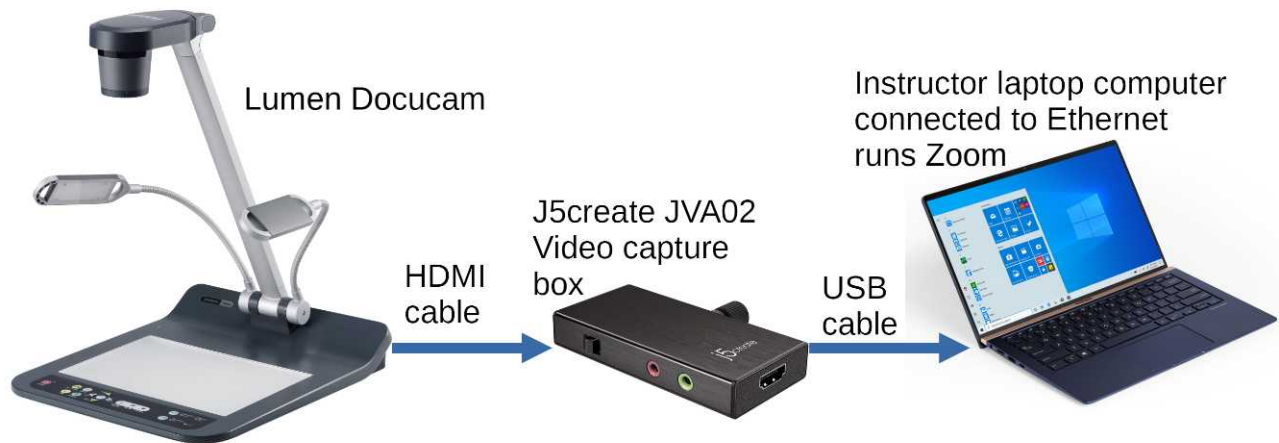

Process for Screen share during Zoom meeting

Start the Zoom app and connect to the Zoom meeting.

Turn on the Docucam and turn on its lights.

In the Zoom application, the up-arrow to the right of the Video start/stup button provides a list of cameras. In that list, you will see at least:

HP

J5create

The HP camera is built into the laptop screen. That must be the default selected camera for this process to work.

The meeting Host must grant co-host status to Zoom on the Instructor laptop.

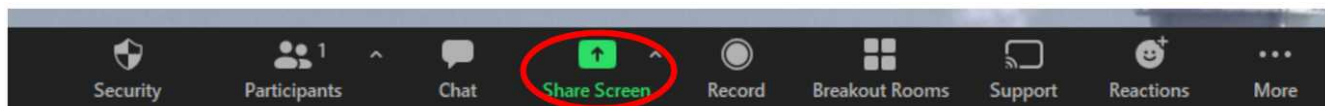

In Zoom on the laptop, reveal the Zoom tool bar, and click the **Share Screen button**, which is circled in illustration 2.

Zoom opens a window listing of running apps and screens available to be shared. That list is the **Basic** tab; there is also an **Advanced** tab.

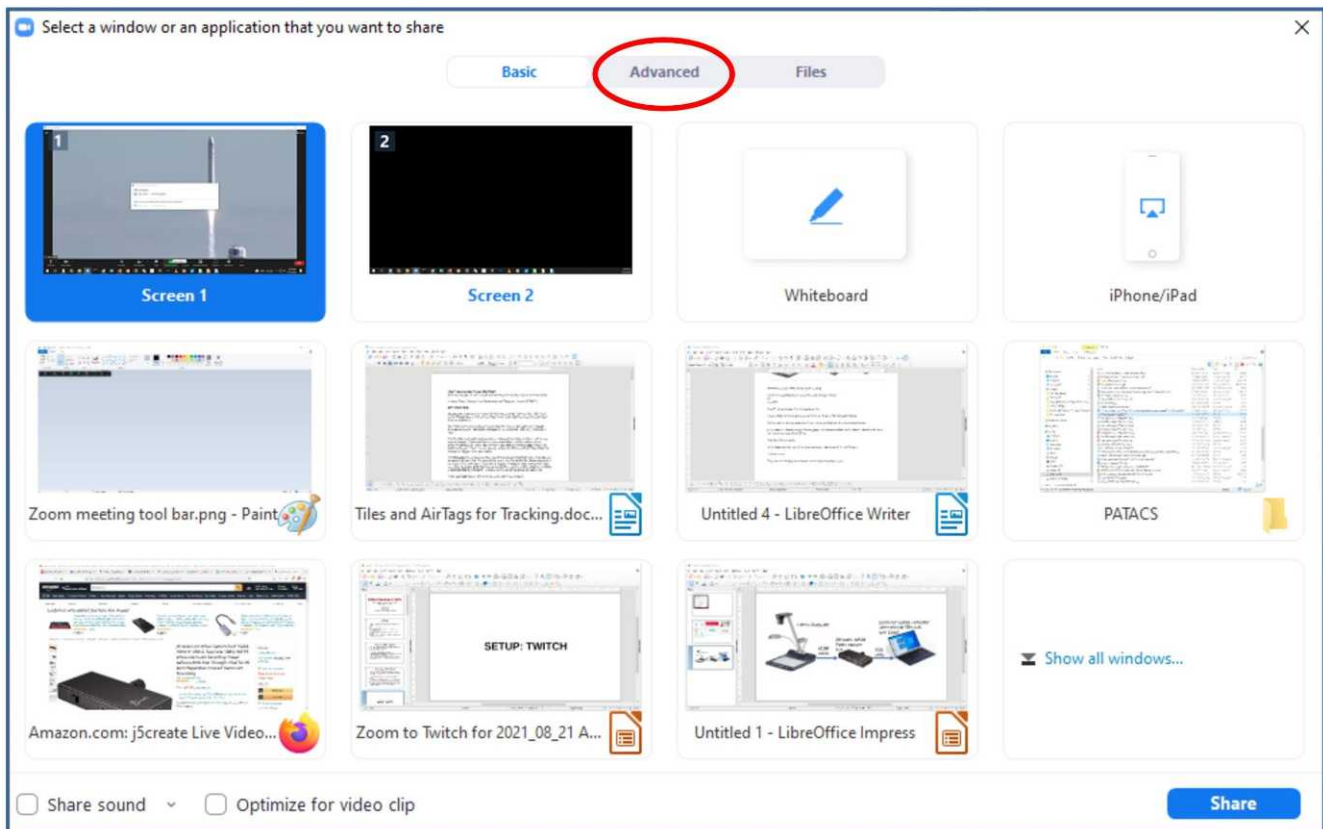

Click the Advanced tab, which is circled in illustration 3.

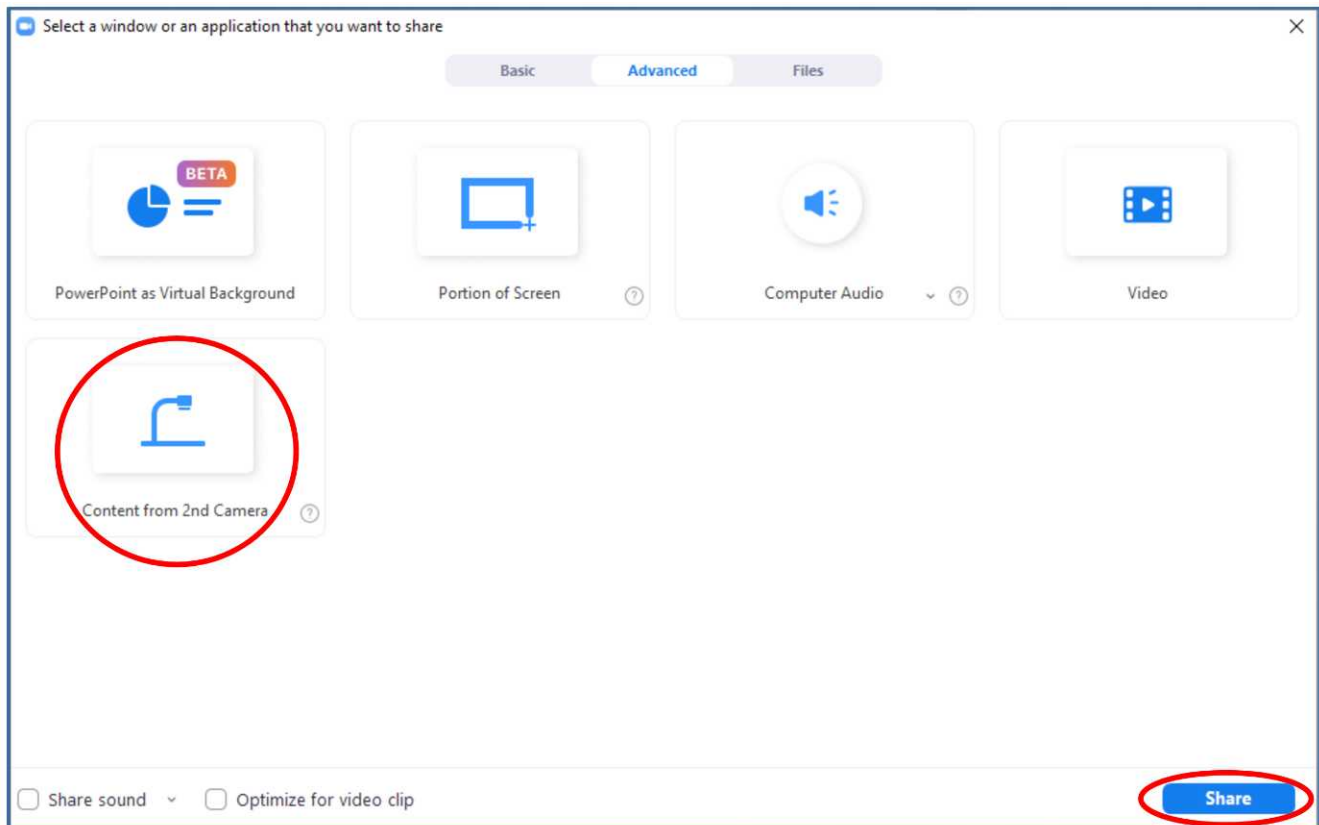

In the Advanced tab, one of the icons available to be shared is **Content from 2nd Camera**.

Click that **Content from 2nd Camera icon**, which is circled in illustration 4.

Click the **Share** button in the lower right corner. It too is circled in illustration 4.

The output of the Docucam appears on the Zoom meeting screen for all meeting participants.

Limits of this procedure: the speaker image thumbnail is **not visible in the upper right corner of Zoom**, unless the speaker literally faces the laptop camera.
